Experience a three night cruise through the Inside Passage and travel the Alaska Highway from the Yukon to Alaska's spectacular Interior.

DAY 1: FLY TO SEATTLE
We have accommodations in suburban Seattle this evening.

DAY 2: BON VOYAGE
After our included breakfast, we drive to Vancouver, British Columbia and board the *ms Volendam* for a three night cruise through the Inside Passage. All meals aboard ship are included. **B,L,D**

DAY 3: THE INSIDE PASSAGE
Experience the mountain and coastal scenery of the Inside Passage. This fjord-like waterway traces the Pacific coast of Canada and Southeast Alaska and remains a vital link between coastal towns. Savor the spectacular views of snow-capped mountains, lush forests, plus hundreds of islands and coastal inlets. There are a variety of shipboard activities to enjoy. Evening brings delightful shows, music and dancing. **B,L,D**

DAY 4: JUNEAU/TRACY ARM
Early this morning we cruise through Tracy Arm Fjord. We may observe a calving glacier as the ship glides past Sawyer Glacier. This afternoon, the *ms Volendam* sails into Grening in Juneau, accessible only by sea or air. We can shop and sightsee ashore on our own or take an optional shore excursion. **B,L,D**



**DAY 5: SKAGWAY/
WHITEHORSE**

After breakfast, we dock in Skagway. An excursion is included aboard the historic *White Pass & Yukon Route Railway*, following the route of the Klondike Goldseekers. Tonight we stay in Whitehorse. **B,L**

DAY 6: YUKON TERRITORY

The Alaska Highway was constructed during World War II as a military route linking Alaska with the lower 48 states. This evening we stay at the Westmark Inn-Beaver Creek where we enjoy dinner and the *Beaver Creek Rendezvous*. **D**

DAY 7: ALASKA HIGHWAY

We travel to Delta Junction. Lunch is at a historic Alaskan roadhouse. Later we view an oil pipeline suspension bridge. Settle in for two nights at the Wedgewood Resort in Fairbanks. Enjoy a delicious dinner this evening. **D**

DAY 8: FAIRBANKS

Board the *Discovery* sternwheeler for a narrated excursion on the Chena and Tanana Rivers. Go ashore at a recreated Athabaskan Indian fishing and trapping camp. See a bush plane take off and land, displaying their unique skills. Lunch is included at the historic Pump House Restaurant. Later, we make a photo stop at the trans Alaska oil pipeline. At the El Dorado Gold Mine, we learn to pan for gold and keep what we find! **B,L**

DAY 9: DENALI PARK TOUR

Enjoy a scenic wilderness drive to Denali National Park. We have lunch on arrival before a guided tundra tour. A park naturalist helps us spot grizzly bear, moose, caribou and other wildlife in their natural habitats. This six-million acre preserve is one of the last and most extensive wilderness regions in the world. Our restful night is at a lodge near Denali. **B,L**

DAY 10: IDITAROD TRAIL

Today's scenic drive takes us to lunch at lovely Settlers Bay Lodge. At the Iditarod Trail Headquarters, we learn about sled dogs and the Anchorage to Nome dog sled race.

Travel through the Matanuska Valley, the center of Alaska's agricultural region. We continue to Anchorage for two nights at the Hilton. **B,L**

DAY 11: 26 GLACIER CRUISE

We drive south along fjord-like Turnagain Arm with views of glaciers and mountains. In Whittier, we cruise on the calm waters of Prince William Sound and view 26 tidewater glaciers. Observing ice break off or "calve" into the sea is exhilarating! **L**

DAY 12: ANCHORAGE

Enjoy a leisurely morning to rest, shop or visit the Anchorage Museum of History and Art. This afternoon we have a wonderful farewell lunch before visiting the Alaska Native Heritage Center. Tonight we board our overnight flight home. **L**

DAY 13: ARRIVE HOME

We arrive home from our Alaskan experiences.
